**NOTICE OF INTENT TO RECEIVE COMMENTS PURSUANT TO
EXECUTIVE ORDER 2023-003**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nevada State Contractors Board will hold a public hearing on March 16, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. to consider potential amendments and removal of various provisions of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 624 pursuant to Executive Order 2023-003 issued by Governor Lombardo on January 12, 2023.

On January 12, 2023, Governor Lombardo issued Executive Order 2023-003 by which he directed that the Board review its regulations (NAC ch. 624) and identify at least ten regulations for removal. The purpose of the hearing is to: (1) vet the Board's recommendations as set out in Attachments A and B; (2) solicit input as to the merits of the Board's recommendations as set out in Attachments A and B; and (3) identify other regulatory changes the attendees feel are worthy of consideration by the Board. A copy of a spreadsheet identifying all of the Board's regulations, including those that may be recommended for removal or amendment, is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the text of those regulations identified for potential removal or amendment is attached as Attachment B.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Nevada State Contractors Board may appear and make oral comment at the scheduled public hearing, or may address their comments, data, views, or arguments, in written form, to the Nevada State Contractors Board, Attention: Susan Kamesch by mail or by email; SBroili-Kamesch@nscb.state.nv.us. Written submissions must be received by the Nevada State Contractors Board on or before March 3, 2023. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request to make an oral presentation, the Nevada State Contractors Board may proceed immediately to act upon any written submission.

NAC 624.136 Criminal investigator: Qualifications. Each person who is employed by the Board as a criminal investigator must:

1. Hold valid certification as a peace officer by the Peace Officers’ Standards and Training Commission pursuant to chapter 289 of NRS; and
2. Have one of the following:
 - (a) A high school diploma and have at least [~~5~~] 4 years of experience in law enforcement or criminal investigations, or equivalent experience, as determined by the Board;

(b) ~~[A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in criminal justice, law enforcement, or a related area of study as determined by the Board, and have at least 4 years of experience in law enforcement or criminal investigations, or equivalent experience, as determined by the Board;]~~ or

~~[-(e)]~~ Any sufficient combination of education and experience as determined by the Board.

3. Possess a Nevada Driver's license and be insurable as a driver under a motor vehicle liability policy obtained by the Board.

4. The moving party may serve and file a written reply only if an opposition to the motion has been served and filed *and only if it is filed at least two days before the scheduled hearing in the matter.*
5. The Board or its designee may issue a decision on a motion without oral argument.
6. If the Board or its designee wishes to oppose a motion, the Board or its designee is not required to serve or file a written response to the motion.
