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## STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD

### MINUTES OF THE WORKSHOP BEFORE THE NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD HELD NOVEMBER 29, 2007

The workshop was called to order at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, November 29, 2007 at the offices of the State Contractors Board, 2310 Corporate Circle, Henderson, Nevada and video-conferenced to the Reno office. Exhibit 1 is the Notice of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation and a copy of the proposed regulations.

Ms. Grein explained the purpose of the workshop is to receive public comment on proposed amendments to Chapter 624 of the Nevada Administrative Code to revise and streamline the language of three license classifications, the C-1 (Plumbing & Heating); C-13 (Sheet Metal) and C-21 (Refrigeration and Air Conditioning) to make the language more consistent with current trade practices. The Legislative Counsel Bureau File Nos. are R091-07, R092-07 and R095-07. Ms. Grein indicated that written comments had been received from the Plumbing-Heating-Cooling Contractors Association; Royal Metal Works; and Southwest Air Conditioning. Ms. Grein announced that the hearing scheduled for December 7, 2007 is cancelled and an additional workshop and public hearing will be held at a later date.

Ms. Grein indicated that the notice of the workshop and hearing had been posted in compliance with NRS 233B at the Las Vegas City Hall, the Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Courthouse, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall and the offices of the State Contractors Board in Reno and Henderson.

Several members of the public were present to offer comment on the proposed amendments.

Mr. Richard Lisle, Executive Director of MCA of Southern Nevada provided comments concerning the addition of a subclassification for rescue air systems used by fire fighters. He indicated he would further review the amendments and provide additional comments. He also offered to coordinate the submission of consensus comments for the various interested parties and stated he felt those comments could be provided within 30 days.

Glen Trowbridge, representing LMCC IBEW and NECA suggested that language be added to clarify the types of solar equipment to be allowed under the classification.

Brian Kerzetski expressed concerns with the proposed amendment that merges the language of the C-1(g) and C-1(j) subclassifications.

Ms. Cavin indicated it is not the intent of the amended language to require landscape contractors to obtain a C-1(d) license.

Mark Larkin commented on the C1(g) chilled water piping subclassification language and indicated he would provide written comments.

Greg Esposito, Business Representative, Plumbers & Pipefitters, Local 525 provided comments concerning the consolidation of the language concerning Industrial Piping and the C1(d) language concerning the installation of water and gas piping between the building and utility meter.

Doug Williams commented concerning chilled water piping; the installation of kitchen equipment and the inclusion of industrial piping in the C1 classification.

There being no further public comment, Ms. Grein closed the workshop at 10:27 a.m. Ms. Grein stated an additional workshop and hearing on the proposed amendments will be scheduled at a later date.
