MINUTES OF THE WORKSHOP BEFORE THE NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD HELD DECEMBER 11, 2007

The workshop was called to order at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, December 11, 2007 at the offices of the State Contractors Board, 2310 Corporate Circle, Henderson, Nevada and video-conferenced to the Reno office. Exhibit 1 is the Notice of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation and a copy of the proposed regulation.

Ms. Grein explained the purpose of the workshop is to receive public comment on proposed amendments to Chapter 624 of the Nevada Administrative Code to revise the current language of the C-42 license classification by eliminating the reference to "community antenna television systems" and replacing the language with "video service networks" to comply with the provisions of NRS 624.218 enacted by the 2007 legislature and to establish a limit on asbestos removal for a licensed contractor not licensed for abatement or removal of asbestos to comply with NRS 624.220(5) also enacted by the 2007 legislature. The Legislative Counsel Bureau has identified the regulations as R093-07 and R147-07.

Ms. Grein indicated that the notice of the workshop and hearing had been posted in compliance with NRS 233B at the Las Vegas City Hall, the Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Courthouse, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall and the offices of the State Contractors Board in Reno and Henderson.

Mr. Richard Daly representing Laborers Local 179 spoke concerning the provisions of R147-07 and expressed support for the regulation as written. There were no other written or verbal comments received.

Since there were no other comments on the proposed amendments, Ms. Grein closed the workshop. Ms. Grein stated a hearing on the proposed amendment will be held Thursday, December 13, 2007 at 10 a.m.

The workshop was adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
