MINUTES OF THE HEARING BEFORE THE NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD HELD JULY 15, 2008

The hearing was called to order at 10:00 A.M. on Tuesday, July 15, 2008 at the offices of the State Contractors Board, 2310 Corporate Circle, Henderson, Nevada and video-conferenced to the Reno office. Exhibit 1 is the Notice of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation and a copy of the proposed regulation.

Ms. Grein explained the purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment on proposed amendments to Chapter 624 of the Nevada Administrative Code. LCB File No. R090-08 adds the word "design" to the sub-subclassifications A10(a)(b) and (d).

Ms. Grein indicated that the notice of the hearing had been posted in compliance with NRS 233B at the Las Vegas City Hall, the Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Courthouse, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall and the offices of the State Contractors Board in Reno and Henderson. A workshop on the proposed regulation was held July 11, 2008.

Ms. Julie Prinze, of Desert Drafting was present at the hearing and again stated her concerns about the proposed regulation's impact on her business. She indicated that she does not construct pools, that she drafts plans for homeowners' pools, and provides the plans to a professional engineer for his submittal to the appropriate Building Department. Ms. Prinze stated that it is her opinion the regulation will adversely impact homeowners if she is required to become licensed since she will have to raise the fees she currently charges.

Ms. Grein reiterated that the regulation simply mirrors the language already in statute.

Since there were no other members of the public present to comment on the proposed amendment, Ms. Grein closed the hearing. Ms. Grein stated the proposed amendment will be presented to the Board for its consideration on July 24, 2008.

The hearing was adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
