**MINUTES OF THE HEARING**  
**APRIL 28, 1999**

The hearing of the State Contractors' Board was called to order by Nancy Mathias, Licensing Administrator, at 9:11 a.m., Wednesday, April 28, 1999, State Contractors Board, Las Vegas, Nevada.

The purpose of the meeting was to hear a proposed change to NAC 624.130. Notice of the hearing was posted in compliance with NRS 233B on March 10, 1999. It was posted at the Las Vegas City Hall, Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Court House, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall and in both offices of the State Contractors Board.

The workshop to solicit comment on the proposed amendment was held on February 23, 1999 in the office of the Board in Las Vegas at 4220 South Maryland Parkway, Las Vegas. No one from the general public attended that workshop.

The proposed amendment will increase the following fees:

- The fee to issue a duplicate license.
- The fee to issue a duplicate identification card.
- The fee to consider a change in the name of the licensee.
- The fee to consider an application for an increase in the monetary limit for a single project.
- To supply a report containing information regarding not more than 500 current licensees.
- To supply a report containing information regarding more than 500 current licensees.
- To consider a permanent increase or decrease in a licensee's monetary limit.
- To consider a change of the qualified person or corporate officer on a license.
- To consider a request to broaden a license to include a classification or subclassification not currently held.
- To increase the fee to renew a license.
- To put in place the fee to administer a cash bond account if the licensee currently holds a cash bond or subsequently posts one.
- To increase the fee to issue a new license.

All other fees will remain the same.
