**MINUTES OF THE MEETING**

**January 18, 2017**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Licensee was not present nor represented by counsel at the hearing.

**ALJ Juan affirmed the Order of November 16, 2016 revoking license number 69631, Edward Monroe Olson, Owner, dba B.O.A. Construction.**

**ALJ Juan found Respondent guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(7) failure to comply with an order of the Board. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$750.00 for the First Cause of Action and investigative costs of \$2,508.00. License number 68916, Ion Petrinca, Owner, dba All Repairs was placed on Inactive Status for no more than five (5) years per NRS 624.282(4). Fines and investigative costs are to be paid within thirty (30) days of the January 18, 2017 hearing or license number 68916, Ion Petrinca, Owner, dba All Repairs shall be revoked.**

**3. DISCIPLINARY HEARING:** (Continued from December 14, 2016)

**TONY S. AZIZ, OWNER, dba HONEST HOME IMPROVEMENT,** License No. 72069

Licensee was not present nor represented by counsel at the hearing.

**ALJ Juan found Respondent guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3017(1) substandard workmanship; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NAC 624.700(3)(a) failure to comply with Board's Notice to Correct; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NRS 624.520(1) failure to provide Residential Recovery Fund notice to owner; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3011(1)(b)(4) violation of the laws of this State regarding industrial insurance; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$2,000.00 for the First Cause of Action; a fine of \$1,500.00 for the Second Cause of Action; a fine of \$100.00 for the Third Cause of Action; a fined of \$500.00 for each of the Fourth and Fifth Causes of Action for total fines of \$4,600.00 and investigative costs of \$2,932.00. Respondent was ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$1,300.00 to Jessica Fastow. A current complaint financial statement with bank verification form for all cash accounts that supports the license limit is to be provided to the Board. Fines, investigative costs and restitution is to be paid and a current compliant financial statement that supports the license limit is to be provided within sixty (60) days of the January 18, 2017 hearing or license number 72069, Tony S. Aziz, Owner, dba Honest Home Improvement shall be revoked.**

**6. DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS: DEFAULT ORDERS**

**a. HIDROGO LAWN MAINTENANCE, LLC,** License No. 77154

Licensee was not present but was represented by Eric Roy, Esq. at the hearing.

**ALJ Juan continued this matter to February 15, 2017. License number 77154, Hidrogo Lawn Maintenance, LLC was suspended.**

**b. BEE GREEN ENERGY, LLC,** License Nos. 78089, 78239

Licensee was present but not represented by counsel at the hearing.

**ALJ Juan continued this matter to February 15, 2017. License numbers 78089 and 78239, Bee**

Green Energy, LLC were suspended.

**c. ACCURACY GLASS & MIRROR COMPANY, INC.,** License No. 29964

Licensee was not present nor represented by counsel at the hearing.

ALJ Juan found Respondent Accuracy Glass & Mirror Company, Inc., license number 29964 in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Respondent was found guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3012(2) failure to pay any money when due; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(4) failure to keep in force the bond for the full period required by the Board; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. Fines and investigative costs were not assessed due to Respondent's Chapter 7 bankruptcy filing. License number 29964, Accuracy Glass & Mirror Company, Inc. was revoked.

**4. DISCIPLINARY HEARING:**

**VALLEY CONSTRUCTION & MAINTENANCE, INC.,** License No. 70140

**SONS OF CONSTRUCTION, LLC,** License No. 76945

\* Licensee Valley Construction & Maintenance, Inc. and Robert Joseph Roselli, Sr. were not present nor represented by counsel at the hearing.

Licensee Donald Delno Knight was present but not represented by counsel at the hearing.

ALJ Allison found Respondent Valley Construction & Maintenance, Inc. guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(5) failure to comply with the terms of a construction contract; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NAC 624.700(3)(a) failure to comply with Board's Notice to Correct; one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(1) abandonment of any construction project; one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(4) failure to prosecute a construction project with reasonable diligence; one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(2) abandonment of a construction project when the percentage of the project completed is less than the percentage paid; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. The Seventh Cause of Action was dismissed. Respondent Valley Construction & Maintenance, Inc. was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 for each of the First, Third, Fourth and Fifth Causes of Action; a fine of \$250.00 for the Second Cause of Action; and a fine of \$500.00 for the Sixth Cause of Action for total fines of \$4,750.00 and investigative costs of \$2,036.00. License number 70140, Valley Construction & Maintenance, Inc. was revoked. Respondent is required to make full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund plus pay the fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.

**5. DISCIPLINARY HEARING:**

**FAITH VISION, INC., dba VISION BUILDERS,** License No. 74754

Licensee was present and represented by Scott Olifant, Esq. at the hearing.

ALJ Allison continued this matter to February 15, 2017. Respondent was ordered to provide a current compliant financial statement with bank verification form for all cash accounts that supports the license limit by January 28, 2017 or license number 74754, Faith Vision, Inc., dba Vision Builders shall be suspended.

**ADJOURNMENT**


There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned by ALJ Allison at 3:12 p.m.
