MINUTES OF THE HEARING BEFORE THE NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD HELD NOVEMBER 8, 2017

The hearing was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, November 8, 2017 at the offices of the State Contractors Board, 2310 Corporate Circle, Henderson, Nevada and video-conferenced to the Reno office. Exhibit 1 is the Notice of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation and a copy of the proposed regulation.

Ms. Grein indicated that the notice of the hearing was posted in compliance with NRS 233B at the Paseo Verde Library, Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Courthouse, South Valleys Library, Reno City Hall and the offices of the State Contractors Board in Reno and Henderson. In addition, the notice was posted on the Board's website and the State of Nevada's Public Notice website.


Ms. Grein explained the purpose of the hearing was to receive comments from interested parties concerning the proposed regulation identified as LCB file R042-17. The proposed regulation is the result of SB 69 passed during the 2017 Legislative session which requires the agency to adopt regulations which provide for licensure by endorsement.

The proposed regulation requires the Board to determine if the requirements for licensing a contractor in another state or territory are substantially equivalent to those in Nevada, and further authorizes the Board, under certain circumstances, to endorse the experience qualifications of an applicant licensed in that state, and recognize an examination taken and passed in that state or an examination accredited by the National Association of State Contractors Licensing Agencies.

Section 2 of the regulation also requires the Board to deem an application withdrawn if the Board has not received within 6 months after the date the application was submitted to the Board all the information required to complete an application; and makes conforming changes related to submittal of fingerprints.

Ms. Grein noted that no written comments were submitted, however Jeanette Belz with the Associated General Contractors Nevada Chapter was in attendance at the November 2nd workshop but did not offer comment. Ms. Grein stated that this matter will be scheduled for the next board meeting on November 16, 2017. The hearing was adjourned at 9:03 a.m.
