BOARD TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST FOUR CONTRACTORS

(Henderson, NV) – At its meeting on January 28-29, 2003, the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated cases against four (4) licensed contractors.

Grizzly Construction, license number 42743 (General Building) and *USA Engineering & Construction*, license number 42742 (General Engineering) based out of North Las Vegas, Nevada were found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for allowing use of the license by an unlicensed person; unauthorized use of a license; bidding to contract in excess of established license limit; disregard of state building laws; and, failure to comply with a notice to correct. The Board revoked the licenses of Grizzly Construction and USA Engineering & Construction.

Landscape Creations By Executrim, license number 48547 (Landscape Contracting) and *Landscape Creations LV Inc.*, license number 54075 (Landscape Contracting) based out of Las Vegas, Nevada were found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for willful disregard of state building laws; substandard workmanship; advertising beyond the scope of the license; acting in the capacity of a contractor under a name different than that on the license; and, bidding to contract in excess of established monetary limit. A two-year letter of reprimand was placed in the licensee's file, the licensee was assessed a \$3,500 fine and the cost of investigation.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.

The Board will convene next in Reno, NV February 10-11, 2003.
